The best way to prepare for a trip is to learn a little about your destination. Here are some facts about JPII to get you started:

-  JPII opened in 2010 with 20 students.
-  Our Eagles have given more than 10,000 hours of service to those in need.
-  87% of students participate in athletics.
-  100% take four years of mathematics; 74% take more than three years of science.
-  90% have gone on to college.
-  Of those, 63% have chosen faith-based colleges.
-  Our alumni have been awarded more than \$20 million in merit-based scholarships to colleges and universities across the country.
